## Air Connectivity

Nauru Airlines connects the island to key destinations, including Brisbane, Nadi (Fiji), Tarawa (Kiribati), Majuro (Marshall Islands), and Honiara (Solomon Islands), with multiple flights per week. This connectivity ensures that visitors can easily reach Nauru while experiencing the charm of the Pacific along the way.

# Contribution Option

The Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Program offers a straightforward pathway to citizenship through a direct contribution to the Treasury Fund of Nauru. For a single Principal Applicant, the contribution amount is USD 105,000. A Principal Applicant with up to three dependents contributes USD 110,000, while a Principal Applicant with four or more dependents contributes USD 115,000. An additional sibling of the Principal Applicant or their spouse can be included for USD 15,000.

Your contribution will enable the Nauruan government to fund various development projects, potentially including climate resilience initiatives, infrastructure improvements, renewable energy projects, and sustainable economic diversification efforts. By contributing to Nauru, you are securing citizenship as well as playing a part in the nation’s sustainable development.

### Application fee

- USD 25,000 for a single Principal Applicant
- USD 27,500 for a Principal Applicant with up to three dependents
- USD 30,000 for a Principal Applicant with four or more dependents

### Due diligence fee

- USD 10,000 for the Principal Applicant
- USD 7,500 per additional family member aged 16 years old or above (spouse, sibling, child, or qualifying adult dependent)
- USD 7,500 for a benefactor

### Bank due diligence fee and transaction charge

- USD 1,200 for a single Principal Applicant
- USD 1,700 for a Principal Applicant with up to three dependents
- USD 2,200 for a Principal Applicant with four or more dependents

### Passport fee

- USD 500 per passport, to be paid to the Nauru Government





## Application Process and Eligibility

Applying for the Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Program is a structured process, guided by licensed Agents and the Nauru Program Office. It begins with an initial consultation with an Agent, followed by document preparation and application submission. Applicants undergo thorough due diligence checks and are required to attend an online interview. Upon approval, applicants make the required contribution, take the Oath of Allegiance to Nauru, and receive their certificate of citizenship and Nauruan passport.

To be eligible for the Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Program, applicants must be of good character, with no criminal record, pass rigorous due diligence checks, have the financial capacity to make the required contribution, and principal applicants must be at least 18 years of age. Additional requirements include providing a police clearance certificate and demonstrating that you are not a potential threat to national security.

### Process

- 1 Contact an Agent for eligibility assessment
- 2 Agent gathers and submits required documents and fees
- 3 Application undergoes government and international due diligence checks
- 4 Attend an interview (virtual or in-person)
- 5 Application reviewed, approved, and contribution made
- 6 Take the Oath of Allegiance
- 7 Receive citizenship certificate and Nauru passport

The process typically takes three to four months.



## Nauru: A Nation of Opportunity

Despite its small size, Nauru offers a wealth of potential for its citizens. The nation's maritime territory presents opportunities for investment and development, particularly in areas such as sustainable fishing and maritime infrastructure. Nauru's unique coral landscapes and pristine waters position it as an emerging eco-tourism destination, with potential incentives for early investors in this sector. The country is also exploring innovative technologies for renewable energy and water desalination, aiming to establish

itself as a center for climate resilience research and development, which could offer exciting prospects for environmentally-conscious investors.
